



PSAV Recycling Programs



PSAV and Waste Management have teamed up to provide recycling services to help PSAV protect the environment.

PSAV has dedicated a significant amount of effort to analyze the environmental impact of its daily operations in order to reduce our carbon and hazardous waste footprint. PSAV has rolled out new programs to recycle consumable items and equipment hardware in environmentally friendly ways. PSAV has partnered with Waste Management, Inc. to offer the "Lamp Tracker" and "eScrap Tracker" recycling programs to employees in each of its more than 700 U.S. office locations.

The "Lamp Tracker" program provides containers to recycle batteries, lamps/bulbs and other consumable items containing mercury. Each PSAV location has its own account and deals directly with Waste Management and UPS to have their full containers picked up and empty containers delivered. Empty containers are ordered through Waste Management's Web site and arrive with pre-addressed return shipping labels.

Batteries and projector lamps comprise the vast majority of consumable items dealt with by the "Lamp Tracker" program. Virtually every projector lamp PSAV uses today contains mercury and is subject to recycling via "Lamp Tracker."

The "eScrap Tracker" program is for recycling hardware only and works in tandem with PSAV's current inventory retirement process. PSAV office location managers just pack retired gear as they normally would and contact PSAV's Equipment Processing Center to arrange for pick up.

PSAV prides itself on being a good corporate citizen and its recycling efforts offer significant assistance in reducing carbon footprints caused by the production of meetings and events.
